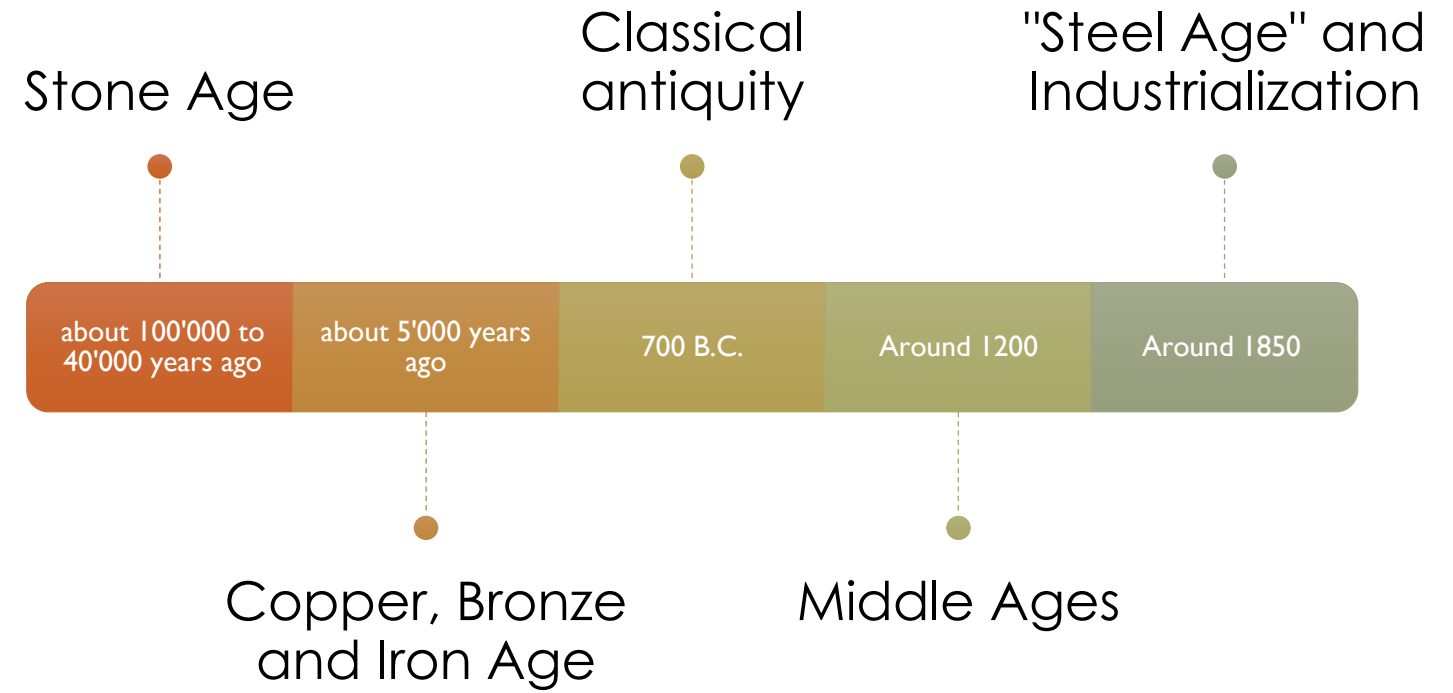

STONE AGE

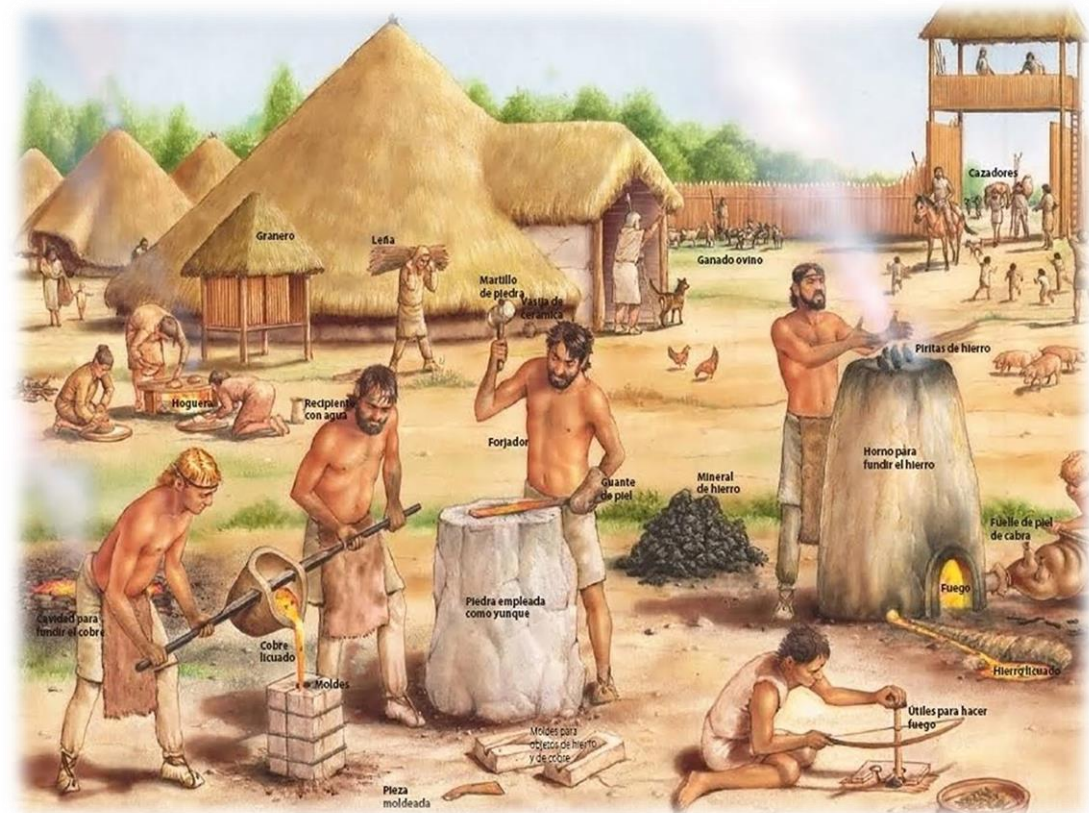
- 100'000 – 40'000 years ago

- Interlocking civilizations

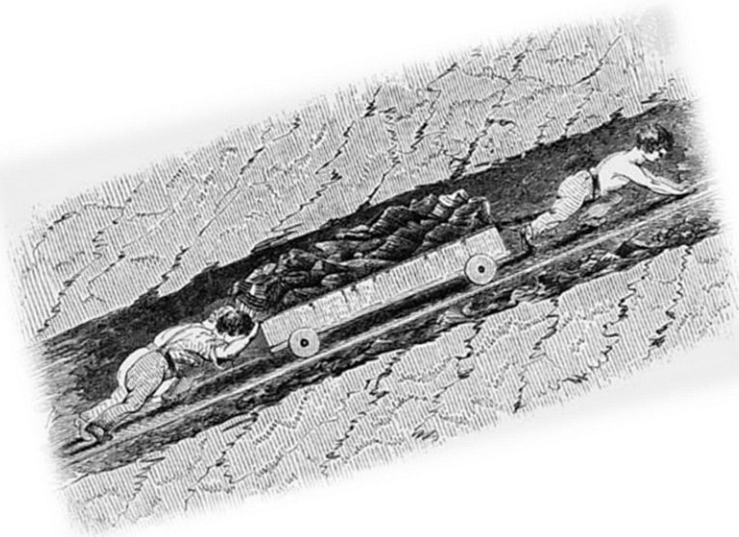


- Introduction of new materials



MIDDLE AGE

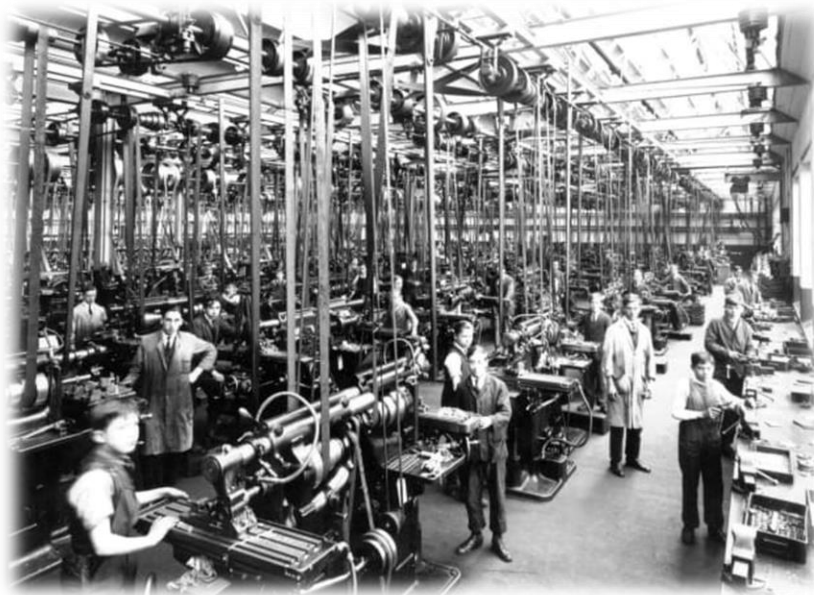
- Around the year 1200
